The average solar panel for homes are rated 300W with 7 to 9 amps of current at 40V. Given that 0.1 to 0.2 amps are lethal for humans, stay away from and do not touch the solar panel terminals.

Once the solar panel gets in any light, it will start charging. If it is in direct sunlight, it has a charge of electricity that can shock you if things go wrong.

In my experience if you're using stainless steel clips, not fully loading them (I try to only put 3 wires in a 4-wire clip, 1 wire in a 2-wire clip), and not putting the wires under strain or making ...

Yes, you've got to complete the circuit to get shocked. But that's harder to do if you don't touch any portion of the conductor. Maybe make your MC4 crimps when not connected to the panels ...
